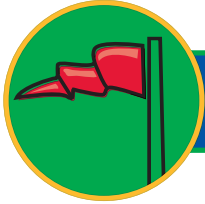

Please make sure you bring these things with you...

- Dress is casual and comfortable
- Heavy Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Jacket or heavy coat
- Close toed shoes like tennis shoes
- Extra blankets
- Flashlight
- Notebook, pen or pencil
- Bible
- Air mattresses are provided but bring your own if you prefer
- Rain Coat (just in case)
- Towel and shower shoes
- Personal Toiletries
- Insect repellent
- Long pants or jeans

In keeping with the "Outback" environment, please leave these things behind:

- Cell Phones (*can be left in the car*)
- MP3 players, iPads, iPods, laptops, netbooks, tablets, etc...
- Cards and games, including electronic gaming devices
- Non-prescription drugs or illegal drugs
- Short shorts
